Rakesh Nangia, chairman of Nangia Andersen LLP said, "our growth mode will continue to accelerate, we plan to hire 1000 professionals in the next two years."

Over the last three years, there has been extensive growth in terms of hiring, we have grown from 335 professionals to 800 plus professionals including senior leaders from industry. In the last few years, we have expanded our offerings to include cyber security, ESG, forensics, government and public sector advisory, IT, and defence advisory, he added.

Among the Big Four accounting firms, KPMG India has a strategy to hire 20,000 people in the next 2-3 years, while its competitor Deloitte India is planning to hire 50,000 people over the next 3-5 years. Similarly, professional services firms Grant Thornton Bharat and BDO India are looking at hiring more than 4500 and 2500 employees respectively in FY24, while business consulting firm Nangia Andersen LLP is confident of hiring 1000 professionals in the next two years, the spokespersons from respective firms told ETCFO.
