Tanushree Roy, Director – Indirect Tax, Nangia Andersen India says that the drafting of the Central Excise Bill 2024 is a critical step towards modernising India's tax framework and ensuring that it is in line with the current economic environment and GST legislation.

The bill has been drafted keeping in mind the limited applicability of the law in respect of specific goods that are leviable to Central Excise duty such as certain tobacco and petroleum products. "This is a much needed revamp as majority of the goods are not leviable to Central Excise law pursuant to the introduction of GST in the year 2017," said Brijesh Kothary – Partner, [Khaitan & Co.](#)
